Each year in Texas, nearly **1,200 children younger than 20** are diagnosed with cancer. At Any Baby Can, we serve children with cancer through in-home case management and resource navigation.

Who Does Any Baby Can's Candlelighters Childhood Cancer program serve?

We provide services and support so that no family goes through their journey with childhood cancer alone. Home-based services span from diagnosis, throughout treatment, during times of crisis and can continue when the child completes treatment. Any Baby Can also provides bereavement services.

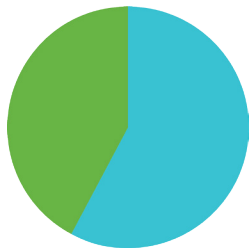
How We Help

Any Baby Can helps children ages 0 - 21-years-old who have cancer or another chronic illness by providing their families with:

- Home-based medical case management and resource navigation including insurance options, medical systems, school and community resources to create an effective advocacy team for the child
- Emotional and peer support, and family events
- Support groups
