Healthy Fair Start (HFS) strengthens low-income families with children younger than four-years-old whose well-being is at risk or who have a mild developmental delay. Any Baby Can team members utilize Parents as Teachers®, an evidence-based curriculum focusing on home-based parent education and child development, to achieve these goals.

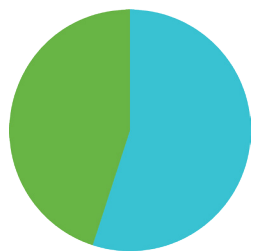
How We Help

HFS home visitors work with families in their home to improve parental confidence and competence, leading to greater family stability as well as appropriate emotional development of the child. We do this by:

- Creating stable and safe family environments
- Addressing developmental delays
- Increasing school readiness and encouraging parent involvement in school and community
